INVITATION FOR BIDS

SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF ARTIFICIAL INSEMINATION FIELD EQUIPMENT

1. The Royal Government of Cambodia (RGC) has received loans/grants from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) and the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) toward the cost of Greater Mekong Subregion Cross-Border Livestock Health and Value Chains Improvement Project (CLHVCIP), and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of these loans and grants to payments under the Contract Reference No. CAM-MAFF-CLHVCIP-G12 for the Supply and Delivery of Artificial Insemination Field Equipment.
2. The Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries (MAFF)/ General Directorate of Animal Health and Production (GDAHP), Cambodia ("the Purchaser") invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for the Supply and Delivery Artificial Insemination Field Equipment (CAM-MAFF-CLHVCIP-G12).
3. Procurement will be conducted through National Open Competitive Bidding Procedures specified in Procurement Plan and the RGC's Standard Operating Procedures on Procurement for All Externally Financed Projects, under the laws and regulations governing public procurement within the Kingdom of Cambodia, and in accordance with the Financing Agreement and Procurement Regulations of Asian Development Bank (ADB).
4. This invitation is open to all eligible bidders from eligible source countries as described in the Bidding Document.
5. 6. **Qualification requirements include:**
 - ❖ The documentary evidence of the Bidder's qualifications to perform the contract if its bid is accepted shall establish to the Purchaser's satisfaction:
 - (a) Copies of original documents defining the constitution or legal status, place of registration, and principal place of business evidencing legal status in an eligible source country as defined in GCC Sub-Clause 6.1.
 - (b) If indicated in the **BDS** that, in the case of a Bidder offering to supply goods under the contract which the Bidder did not manufacture or otherwise produce, the Bidder has been duly authorized by the goods' Manufacturer or producer to supply the goods in Cambodia.
 - (c) The Bidder shall furnish documentary evidence that it meets the following experience and financial requirements:
 - (i) that the Bidder has satisfactorily completed at least two contracts for supply of similar goods in the preceding three years (2023, 2024 and 2025) of not less than **USD 477,160.46** as specified in the **BDS**;
 - (ii) that the bidder has completed contracts in the total cumulative amount equal to at least **USD 954,320.92** in the preceding two years (2024 and 2025) as specified in the **BDS**;
 - (iii) that the Manufacturer of the offered goods, if a different entity from the Bidder, has experience of at least 3 years in the manufacturing of similar goods;
 - (iv) that the Bidder has availability of liquid assets through either:
 - (a). access to a line of credit or cash in bank account of an amount at least **USD 477,160.46** as specified in the **BDS**, net of other contractual commitments; or
 - (b). credit terms with vendors specifically for the goods to be supplied under the contract, and valid for at least 6 months after the deadline date for submission of bids specified in ITB Clause 21.
 - (v) that the Bidder meets any additional qualification criteria listed in **BDS**.
 - 7. A complete set of Bidding Documents in English may be purchased by interested bidders on the submission of a written application to the address given below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee USD 50.00 (Fifty US Dollars) or its equivalent in Cambodian Riel being KH Riel 200,000. The method of payment will be in cash or direct deposit to Bank Account No. **0000000013535** of National Bank of Cambodia. The Bidding Documents will be

collected in person or may be sent by email or courier, at the discretion of the bidder, but the bidder has to deposit the fee at the above bank account and to pay for courier charge by his/her arrangement as appropriate. Other than payment of the non-refundable fee specified above, there shall be no other conditions for purchase of the bidding documents.
