1. The Kingdom of Cambodia has received financing from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) and the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) toward the cost of the **Greater Mekong Subregion Cross-Border Livestock Health and Value Chains Improvement Project (CLHVCIP)**. Part of this financing will be used for payments under the Contract named above. Bidding is open to Bidders from eligible source countries of ADB.
2. The **Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries (MAFF)** ("the Employer") invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for the construction and completion of **National Cattle Breeding Center (NCBC)** in Kampong Chhnang province of Cambodia. ("the Works"). The construction period is 18 months from the date of notification to commence.
3. Open competitive bidding – National advertisement will be conducted in accordance with ADB's Single Stage: One Envelope without Prequalification procedure and is open to all Bidders from eligible countries as described in the Bidding Document.
4. Only eligible Bidders with the following key qualifications defined in the Bidding Document may participate in this bidding:
Financial:
The Bidder shall have a minimum average annual construction turnover of **USD 7,150,000.00**, calculated as total payments received for contracts in progress or completed within the last three (3) years (2023, 2024, and 2025).
The Bidder must demonstrate that its financial resources less its financial obligations for its current contract commitments meet or exceed the total requirement for the Subject Contract of **USD 888,000.00**.
Experience:
The Bidder shall have Participated in at least two contracts that have been successfully or substantially completed within the last 5 years (2021, 2022, 2023, 2024, and 2025) and that are similar to the proposed works, where the value of the Bidder's participation exceeds **USD 4,330,680.00**. The similarity of the Bidder's participation shall be based on the physical size, nature of work, complexity, methods, technology, or other characteristics as described in the Bid Document Section 6 (Employer's Requirements).
